Judge's Remarks

The rich variety and high level of quality of the paintings submitted indicate a healthy and promising state of affairs in the art of this country. The clash of allegiances, the fragmentations of styles which are the sign of our times, are clearly no nearer resolution here than anywhere else and make difficult the task of an adjudicator who is necessarily beset by subjective as well as objective desiderata.

I hope it will be understood by those whose pictures have not been hung that their exclusion is not necessarily a judgment of their quality. The selection has been partly determined by the needs of the exhibition and while I am satisfied that all the pictures shown are good, not all of the good pictures could be shown, and it is to be hoped that a second selection may be exhibited later.

It is a great tribute to Hay's Ltd. that this competition has produced such an overwhelming response. The prizes are a generous gesture of assistance to the artists and the success of the venture must give a fillip to the arts in New Zealand.
